



(Council, Capability Priorities, NDPP)

**Bottom-up:** Standardization Proposal

(any interested party)

### **Bottom-up Requirements Identification**

#### **Through a Standardization Proposal (SP)**

- initiates the bottom-up standardization process
- can be submitted by <u>any interested party</u>
- shall be developed in accordance with SP format provided in AAP-03
  - (available on NSO website)





## The Standardization Task - Important Take Away -

- will only be developed, if responses to SI indicate that need and capacity to contribute to the development are confirmed by Allies
- development is responsibility of TA/DTA staff but will require support from national SMEs and, if appropriate, NATO bodies' staff
- specifies the intended standardization solution
- (gives specific guidance to custodian)
- ☐ shall be developed in accordance with ST format in AAP-03 (available on NSO website)
- Requires TA/DTA approval
