


What is the NDPP?

Defence Planning in NATO is a 5 step, quadrennial process which drives Allies to allocate or develop and deliver, when required, forces with the required interoperable capabilities and readiness to ensure that the Alliance successfully achieves its level of ambition.




Aim/Purpose of the NDPP



- To provide a common framework for national and Alliance defence planning activities
- To harmonize national and Alliance defence planning activities to meet NATO agreed targets
- To facilitate the timely identification, development and delivery of military and non-military capabilities
- To ensure that national contributions are interoperable and adequately prepared, equipped, trained and supported

NDPP targets formally covers the short-term (0-6 years) and the medium-term (7- 19 years)

NDPP Steps and Products

Standardization in the NDPP

- Standardization and Interoperability one of 14
 planning domains contributing to the various stands
 of capability development through the NDPP
- NDPP Outline Model: 'NATO staffs will facilitate the development and implementation by Allies of agreed common standards (e.g. STANAGs and Allied Publications)'
- More focus on interoperability and standardization due to increased multinationality of high-readiness tactical forces
- Use of NDPP as tool to encourage Allies to improve national implementation of standards



THE NATO DEFENCE PLANNING PROCESS

- The NATO Defence Planning Process (NDPP) was agreed by Council under a silence procedure on 24 October 2016.
- The Defence Policy and Planning Committee (Reinforced) reviewed proposed changes to PO(2016)0655 (INV) – The NATO Defence Planning Process (NDPP) – in accordance with paragraph 54 of that document, and agreed three changes to the document. They are:
 - a. A new second sentence in paragraph 9: To achieve this balance, the NDPP ensures the appropriate requirements from advanced plans are met and provides flexibility for the development of innovative solutions;
 - An insertion into the second sentence of paragraph 34: promote the implementation of innovative capabilities and to;
 - c. A new footnote at the end of the first sentence of paragraph 36: Footnote 21. Upon request of the Ally concerned, IS/DPP will reflect in the draft Capability Target packages the agreements made by ACT and national representatives during the Joint Consultation Meetings when they entail an important modification in the apportioned target such as the modification in the readiness in one part of it. This circumstance will be shown in the remarks box of the serial related to that target.
- I do not believe this document requires discussion in the Council. Unless I hear to the contrary by 15:30 hours on Friday, 3 June May 2022, I shall assume that Council agrees to the revised NATO Defence Planning Process.





THE 'TOP-DOWN' APPROACH TO NATO STANDARDIZATION



AAP-52 at a Glance




2.9.3. NSO staff officers prepare text contributions to reflect standardization in the Guidance. They advise on standardization issues during the Defence Policy and Planning Committee drafting sessions.

2.9.4. The CS may propose for Defence Policy and Planning Committee (Reinforced).

2.9.7. The CS principals, TAs, national standardization managers, and NSO use the Political Guidance throughout the rest of the NDPP cycle as the first, authoritative source of Allies' guidance for NATO standardization as a contribution to capability development.



Requirement:

Ensure rapid, secure, reliable and survivable information sharing, all deployable land formations assigned to NATO are to have the capability to communicate at the tactical level both in national and multinational formations. Nations are to develop and maintain interoperable tactical communication and information systems (CIS) for individual, platform and command post to Deployable Land Forces to support secure communications, both voice and data, at the tactical level.

Short-Term (0-6 yrs):

- By the beginning of 2018, introduce an individual, platform and command post Tactical CIS interoperable with NATO Force Structure (NFS) elements, capable of:
 - Tactical communication on common agreed VHF and UHF waveform to support deployed forces in compliance with STANAGs 5630, 5631, 5632, 5633, 5634, 4372 and 5048.
 - Integrating with Land Command and Control Information Services (LC2IS) to all NFS tactical level HQs;
 - c. Integrating with a Friendly Force Identifier and Track (FFIT) system in accordance with STANAG 5527 able to track the lowest tactical units deployed in the theatre of operations and able to exchange

2.12.7. The NSO compares Nations' reporting on their implementation of NATO standards to relevant reports of operations, exercises, evaluations, training.


2.12.8. Allies educate and encourage their custodians and representatives in TAs/DTAs/Working Groups to develop implementation paragraphs in their STANAGs.

2.12.14. The NSO assists Allies with capability development by providing input on the work conducted in military, operational standardization to the capability roadmaps.

2.12.20. NSO/TAs/DTAs shall respond to requests and assist in connecting national SMEs to NATO staffs to contribute to Step 4 actions.

2.12.21. SMEs on specific NATO standards should advise and support national project managers for the capabilities to which those standards apply.


