Civil Standards

It is NATO Policy to use suitable non-NATO standards to the maximum practicable extent. By using non-NATO standards, NATO:

- Leverages the expertise of a very wide and diverse set of experts. Civil Standards are developed by a diverse array of types of actors (trade associations, professional societies, industry consortia, international and regional organisations, standards developing organization whose sole purpose is to develop standards etc).
- Ensures the use of the most advanced technologies. Disruptive technological advancements that were once mainly the purview of military development are now most commonly made in the civil sector.
- Decreases the cost of procurement by increasing the customer base. There is a large and increasing civilian customer base for dual-use equipment (police, border control, gendarmes, first responders, private security firms, etc.). Also civilian consumer drives the communication and electronics market.

The Policy and Coordination Branch of the NSO assists NATO committees and working groups in their use of suitable non-NATO standards.

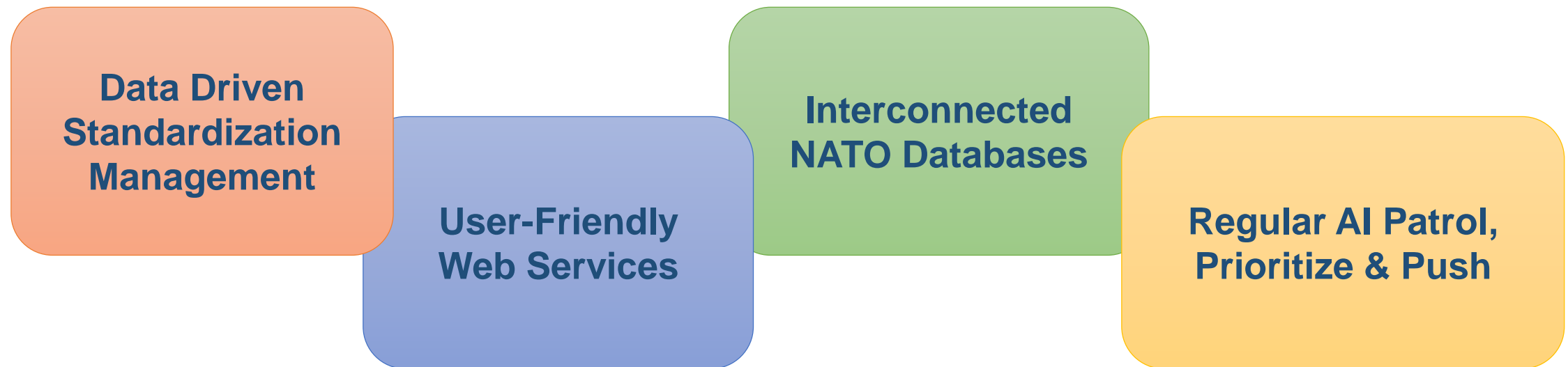

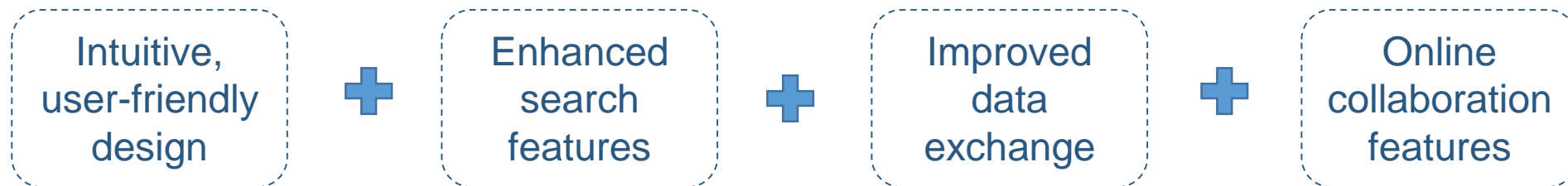

NATOTerm 2.0


- Multi-phase, multi-year project.
