# **NATO Standardization Policy**

NATO <u>shall</u> adopt and refer to suitable non-NATO standards (civil standards and national defence standards) [...] to the maximum extent.


NATO <u>shall</u> only develop a standard where no suitable non-NATO standard exists.

#### **Benefits**

- Leverage the expertise of a very wide and diverse set of experts
- Benefit from the most advanced technologies
- Reduced procurement costs
- Reduced costs for standards production
- Possibly faster availability as Allied standard (reduced time between identification of requirements and availability of standards)

#### **Non-NATO Standards**

# Non-NATO standards include civil standards, national and multinational defence standards.

- A civil standard is a standard published by a civil standardization body and made available to the public. Civil standards are developed, established and coordinated by civil Standard Developing Organizations (SDOs).
- > A **defence standard** is a standard developed by nations or group of nations in the defence field.



#### Civil SDOs

- ➤ Unique organizations
- Specific interests
- Variety of memberships
- ➤ Variety of standards development processes
- ➤ Variety of voting and funding mechanisms




# Standardization Document Development Process

  - ✓ informative references: those listed for information purposes only (not part of the requirement)



#### **Civil Standards SRD**

- Describes types of civil standards and SDOs.
- Provides advice on development, adoption and use.
- Clarifies the roles and responsibilities of the TA, DTA, and Custodians or NATO
   Points of Contact when they participate in civil SDO activities.
- Provides criteria for transfer of NATO standardization documents to SDOs.









#### NSO's role




Advise NATO committees on how to initiate and sustain cooperation projects with SDOs in relevant NATO EDTs.



Report to NATO senior committees on Tasking Authorities' / Delegated Tasking Authorities' progress on SDOs.



Custodian for guidelines (AAP-03(K), Chapter 3; SRD AAP-03.1)



Integrate EDTs into its tools and services for standards development, review and management, address interdependencies and promote their use.
