STANdardization **AG**reement:


- specifies the agreement of member nations to implement Allied standards required to meet an interoperability requirement
- requires national ratification process resulting in a 'formal' national implementation statement

STANdardization **REC**ommendation:

- used exclusively in the materiel field of standardization
- relevant to a specific Alliance activity unrelated to interoperability
- non-binding

NATO STANDARD:

A NATO standard is a standard <u>developed</u> and promulgated <u>in</u> the framework of the <u>NATO</u> standardization process.

NON-NATO STANDARD:

A non-NATO standard is a <u>standard developed outside NATO</u>. Non-NATO standards include civil standards, national and multinational defence standards. Non-NATO standards become Allied Standards when <u>adopted by NATO</u>.



- may provide additional data and information to support the management and implementation of Allied standards.

Examples:

national data catalogues, standards implementation guides, etc.
